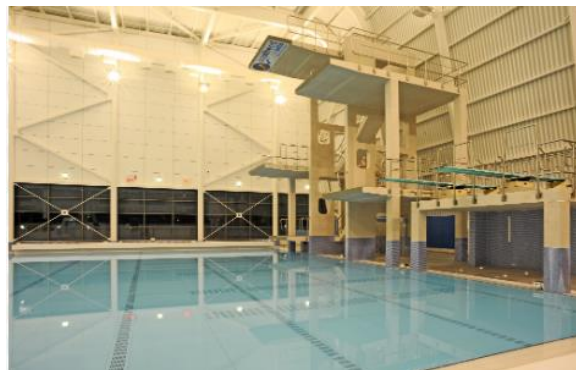

Due to limited pool time at competitions the GBDF reserves the right to close entries before the official closing date should the entries exceed the time allowed.

Divers can take part in a **maximum of 4 events** from the selection of individual and synchro events on offer.

The conditions for the individual events are different for Masters and Novice Masters.

For the synchro events the split is only per age group.

It is possible to take part in some individual events as Novice Master and others as Master if required.

Please indicate on your entry form which **max. 4 events** you want to take part in.

IMPORTANT NOTE

regarding divers aged 16/17

Entries from divers aged 16/17 years old **MUST** be accompanied by a letter signed by the Welfare Officer, or other responsible official, of the diver's club, stating that they will ensure that child protection procedures will be followed, and that the diver will be appropriately chaperoned for the duration of the event.

+Divers must be 16 years of age on or before Friday 15th November 2024.

- The divers can freely choose the dives from the dive table given in the FINA handbook
- Ages as at 31st December in the year of the competition
 - Plus see the important note regarding divers aged 16/17 above
- Age group 16 - 69 years: each dive performed must have a different dive number
 - According to the FINA handbook
- Age group 70 - 80+ years: dives with the same dive number can be repeated, if performed in a different position → straight, tuck, piked or free position
 - This will be counted as a different dive and will receive full DD
- Dives without rotation (jumps; dive no. 'x00') may not be used
 - This does not apply to 600A used on platform as it is a recognised FINA dive

*Masters 50+ years are only allowed feet first entries from the 10m platform, and the DD may not exceed 2.0

CONDITIONS

- Male and Female will perform the same number of dives.

- Ages as at 31st December in the year of the competition
 - Plus see the important note regarding divers aged 16/17 above
- Novices may not perform dives of more than 1.5 rotations or with a FINA tariff over 2.0
- Dives without rotation (jumps; dive no. 'x00') may not be used
 - This does not apply to 600A used on 5m as it is a recognised FINA dive

*Novices may not use the 7.5m or 10m platforms

SYNCHRO CONDITIONS

- You can only enter each synchro event once
- You can synchro with same sex or different sex divers
- Separate medals will be awarded for pairs with a combined age of up to 99 years and pairs with a combined age of 100+
 - The ages of both divers must be added together to ascertain which category to enter, i.e. a pair consisting of an 18-year-old and a 50-year-old would dive in the “Up to 99” years group
- On all synchro dives, the divers must dive in the same direction
 - Any dives with the same number but in a different position, or from a different height, are classed as a repeat (except if one of the divers in the pair is from the 70 – 80+ age groups)
- There is no tariff limit
 - Except that when one of the pair is a novice diver, they may not perform dives of more than 1.5 rotations or with a FINA tariff over 2.0

- Ages as at 31st December in the year of the competition
 - Plus see the important note regarding divers aged 16/17 above
- Dives without rotation (jumps; dive no. ‘x00’) may not be used
 - This does not apply to 600A used on platform as it is a recognised FINA dive

*Novices may not use the 7.5m or 10m platforms

*Masters 50+ years are only allowed feet first entries from the 10m platform, and the DD may not exceed 2.0

Entry fee will be £16 per individual event and £20 per synchro pair (£10 per diver per synchro event)

Friday 15/11/2024	Open training 17.00 until 19.00
Saturday 16/11/2024	1 st competition day
Sunday 17/11/2024	2 nd competition day

*If there is sufficient space after the closing date for entries late entries may be accepted up until 10 November 2024 however a late entry fee of £20 will be applied.

**Late submission of dive sheets will incur a late submission fee of £5.
